Double degree requirements	<p>To be awarded the Bachelor of Arts in International Business of THN and the Bachelor of Business Administration of PU, the students must complete successfully:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <i>At THN:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All courses specified as required in the Bachelor of Arts in International Business program from semester 1, 2, 3, 6 and 7 of THN • Two focus electives from the THN elective course program • Certification of four physical education courses from the University Sports Program Erlangen 2. <i>An internship of at least 20 weeks (full-time)</i> 3. <i>The following PU courses (PU credits) by 2 semester study exchange:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Organizational behavior (3) • Business ethics (2) • Information management (3) • Statistics 2 (3) • Business elective courses (14) • Chinese/General Education/Cultural Course/Physical Education (18) <p>Total workload for 2 semesters: 43 ICPU credits</p>

Application process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application for a double degree via International Office of THN • Application deadline for winter semester is 31st of January and for summer semester is 31st of July • The following documents must be submitted by e-mail: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Application form signed by the responsible academic coordinator ○ Letter of motivation in English ○ CV in English with photo ○ Proof of English language skills ○ Current certificate (Transcript of records) ○ Current enrolment form
