### **Current Information regarding winter semester 21/22**

Dear students,

We are looking forward to seeing you again. We will start again with classroom teaching at the Nuremberg Institute of Technology. To make sure this will work, we all have to follow rules.

You can come back to university if you are vaccinated, recovered, or tested. In all three cases, you must bring an appropriate documentation. In case of testing a rapid antigen test or a PCR test will be sufficient. Masks are still mandatory at university. However, we have now switched to medical masks, FFP2 masks are no longer needed.

Contact data collection is also needed, but you already know this from the last semesters, that you have to register your presence. To do this, you will find codes at the entrances of the buildings or lecture halls. Scan these codes with your cell phone and you will be automatically redirected to VirtuOhm to enter your data. You can also do this comfortably from home the night before, if you know which rooms you will be in, and enter your contact data.

Please note that every content from this video is also available in written form on our homepage. If you have any further questions, please contact us and your faculties or the respective lecturers.

One last remark: the same rules as before Corona apply with regard to presence: "Do I actually have to be at the university?". We only have compulsory attendance in very few cases, for example for internships, as stated in the module handbooks. In most cases you decide whether you come to the campus or not. Of course, it is also important for you to know whether the content of the courses is available online. We have asked our colleagues to provide their content digitally (as we had it now for three digital semesters). If you have any questions, please ask the respective lecturers.
