<p><b>Double Degree</b></p>	<p>Students of THN'S Master in International Finance and Economics (M-IFE) can earn two Master's degrees within two years:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Laurea Magistrale in Economics, Management and Corporate Law</b> (120 ECTS) delivered by Sapienza, Faculty of Economics - Latina site and</li> <li>▪ <b>Master in International Finance and Economics</b> (M.Sc., 90 ECTS) delivered by THN</li> </ul>
<p><b>Sapienza – Università di Roma</b></p>	<p>The Sapienza University of Rome (Sapienza – Università di Roma) is a collegiate research university located in Rome, Italy.</p> <p><b>Some facts:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ With 112,000 students, it is one of the largest European universities.</li> <li>▪ With over 700 years of history, it is one of the oldest European universities.</li> <li>▪ Commonly ranked first in national rankings and in Southern Europe.</li> <li>▪ 270+ degree programs (Bachelor's and Master's), 200+ vocational master courses and almost 80 PhDs.</li> <li>▪ Organized into 11 faculties and 59 departments, as well as numerous research and service centers.</li> </ul> <p>The Faculty of Economics enjoys an excellent reputation for a broad range of subjects covered in the academic curricula and the flexibility of choice offered to students. Over the last few years, the Faculty of Economics has had 10,000 students on average with a high percentage of students coming from abroad.</p> <p><b>Please note</b>, the Laurea Magistrale in Economics, Management and Corporate Law is not held in Rome's city center but at Sapienza's Sede di Latina (Latina site, Viale XXIV Maggio 7, 04100 - Latina).</p>

<p><b>Why a Double Degree?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two full degrees within two years</li> <li>• International exposure</li> <li>• Unique experience abroad</li> <li>• Increased job prospects</li> <li>• Personal development</li> </ul> 
<p><b>Key points</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The double degree includes <b>one semester of academic studies at Sapienza</b>: Students from TH Nürnberg will study at Sapienza during their <b>3th or 4th semester</b> (summer semester, i.e. mid/ end February – beg/ mid July) and have to take a minimum of 30 ECTS at Sapienza.</li> <li>• Upon successful completion of the double degree requirements (120 ECTS), <b>two separate diplomas</b> are conferred to the student according to the local regulations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ The degree from the THN: <b>Master in International Finance and Economics (M.Sc.)</b> together with a diploma supplement and transcript of records.</li> <li>○ The diploma from the Sapienza - University of Rome: <b>“Laurea Magistrale” in Economics, Management and Corporate Law</b>, together with a diploma supplement, if available. The final grade for THN students is based on 72 ECTS from courses at THN (according to MIFE regulations), 30 ECTS from courses at Sapienza and 18 ECTS from the Master’s thesis at THN (topic has to be in the area of economics or finance; written in the English language).</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Courses at Sapienza and THN, which are part of this double degree, will be taught in <b>English</b>.</li> <li>• The <b>Master’s thesis</b> (in English; topic in Finance/ Economics) must be prepared and concluded at TH Nürnberg. A copy of the final thesis will be submitted to Sapienza.</li> <li>• You remain <b>enrolled at TH Nürnberg</b> while being registered Sapienza for the mobility period. Students will pay tuition fees, if any, to their home institution, not the host institution. However, administrative fees etc. might occur at the host institution, which have to be paid by the students.</li> <li>• Students who <b>failed</b> one or more exams at the host institution are required to retake the respective exams at the host institution, yet only once. Repeated failure or missing presence on the date of examination leads to the exclusion of this particular student from the double degree program. This has no direct effect on the continuation of the Master’s program at the home institution.</li> </ul>

<p><b>Who can participate?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students must be enrolled in THN’s Master Program in International Finance and Economics</li> <li>• Selection criteria are grades, language skills and motivation.</li> <li>• Before departing to Sapienza, students must have successfully completed at least 30 ECTS at TH Nürnberg and have a signed Learning Agreement.</li> </ul>																														
<p><b>When to apply</b></p>	<p>Please apply until end June for the semester at Sapienza (summer semester at Sapienza starts mid/ end February and ends beg/ mid July).</p>
