In this case the personal data will be used to be able to identify potential contact persons. The data would also be relayed to the local health authorities in this case. The collection, storage, and eventual use of the data are exclusively carried out for the purpose of protecting your health and the health of possible contact persons. Your data will be destroyed at the latest four weeks after your examination date.

Please inform the Health Protection office at the Technische Hochschule Nürnberg Georg Simon Ohm promptly, if you test positive for Covid-19 within two weeks after your examination.
