At THN: • All courses specified as required in the Bachelor of Arts in International Business program from semester 1, 2, 3, 6 and 7 of THN • Two focus electives from the THN elective course program • Certification of four physical education courses from the University Sports Program Erlangen 2. An internship of at least 20 weeks (full-time) 3. The following PU courses (PU credits) by 2 semester study exchange: • Organizational behavior (3) • Business ethics (2) • Information management (3) • Statistics 2 (3) • Business elective courses (14) • Chinese/General Education/Cultural Course/Physical Education (18) Total workload for 2 semesters: 43 ICPU credits
