## PREPARING AND APPLYING

- Rule of thumb: outside of Europe, ca. 6-12 months preparation time; within Europe, ca. 6 months preparation time
- Documents: usually a CV and cover letter > watch for country-specific differences

## UNIVERSITY FORMALITIES

### *Required internship*

- Preparing: Note the information from each Faculty for each degree programme as well as the Intranet area of the student office <https://ohmportal.de/studium/intranet> > Studienbüro > Praktisches Studiensemester
- Registered organisation: Check and confirm that the position (exact location) has been approved for your degree programme <https://my.ohmportal.de/> > StudyOHM > Studies offered > Search internships
  - If it has not yet been approved, organise the approval of the position with the Internship Officer of your Faculty. Internship Officers: <https://ohmportal.de/studium/intranet> > Studienbüro > Praktisches Studiensemester > Organisation
  - Complete the registration form and have the Internship Officer sign it in order to get the position approved: <https://ohmportal.de/studium/intranet> > Studienbüro > Formulare > Meldebogen (Registration form)
- Internship contract: After the position is approved, the internship contract is signed by the student, host organisation, and the Faculty/Student Office and submitted to the Student Office. <https://ohmportal.de/studium/intranet> > Studienbüro > Formulare
- **Don't forget: Be sure to register for the semester and pay the semester fees as usual!**

### *Voluntary internship*

- The formalities above do not apply; a contract is agreed between the host organisation and yourself.
- If applicable, request a leave of absence from the Student Advisory Service (for internships longer than 2 months) <https://ohmportal.de/studium/intranet> > Studienbüro > Studienorganisation > Beurlaubung

### *Summary of all degree-related experiences abroad*

- The Record of degree-related study abroad should be completed after your stay abroad is completed and submitted via email to the Student Advisory Service <https://ohmportal.de/studium/intranet> > Studienbüro > Formulare

- Monthly amount in WiSe 2025/26 and SoSe 2026: 690 € - 750 € (depending on the country group)
- Submit your application via email, up until 2 months prior to the start of your internship, to Christina Hempel or Joseph Jehlicka, International Office

## VISA

- Exception: USA J1 visa > first request a DS-2019 form from a sponsoring agency, e.g.,
  - o German American Chamber of Commerce New York [www.gaccny.com](http://www.gaccny.com)
  - o Travel Works <http://www.praktikum-usa.org>
  - o College Council [www.college-council.de](http://www.college-council.de)
- South Africa: no internship visas <https://www.suedafrika.org/visa-immigration/temporary-residence-visa.html>

- Note on UK: Since 2021 a T5 visa is required > the host company/organisation must have a licence for a Certificate of Sponsorship (CoS) <https://www.gov.uk/uk-visa-sponsorship-employers/certificates-of-sponsorship>

## INSURANCE

- Health insurance
  - o Europe: Basic health insurance is provided with a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC); private supplementary insurance coverage is strongly recommended (e.g. for return transport, special treatments)
  - o Outside of Europe: Obtain private international health insurance
- Review your liability insurance coverage (foremost, damage caused by policy holder at a place of work abroad)
- Review your accident insurance coverage (foremost, damage at the expense of policy holder at a place of work abroad)
