FIRST WEEK: Well-being

SECOND WEEK: Entrepreneurship

Leading figure: Fabio Papa, Professor of Economics, University of Macerata

The aim of this part is to teach students how to design and develop their own start-up to promote self-employment. Creative thinking and business-oriented philosophical approaches will be mixed to deliver a highly innovative learning experience.

Some of the topics are

• the role of an entrepreneur in modern society,

how to develop a winning business model,

from ideas to reality.

In the afternoon, participants can look forward to visiting Marlenka sweet factory, meeting real start-up companies and enjoying sport activities in our City Campus.



ACCOMMODATION

There are two dormitories in the city centre to choose from (besides other options that can be found via, for example, booking.com).

The rooms are pre-booked for the summer school students, you can mark your preference when filling out the application.

1) J. Opletal Halls of Residence

- University-owned, 10 minutes from the city center (via public transport)
- Double or triple occupancy with shared bathroom
- Price: 13 EUR/night (approx. 180 EUR for two weeks)
- Payment: upon arrival (cash/card)
- A valid travel document is required at check-in

2) Kampus Palace

- Private, modern residence in the city center (walking distance to university buildings)
- Single or double occupancy with personal/shared bathroom
- Price: approx. 350 EUR for two weeks (varies by room type)

CZECHIA

Czechia is a landlocked country in Central Europe. The capital city is Prague and the currency is the Czech crown (CZK). The population is over 10,000,000 people. Culturally, Czechia has a rich history in music, literature, visual arts and decorating glass and crystal.

OSTRAVA

Ostrava is the third largest city in Czechia. It is in the middle of everything just hours from Prague, Berlin, Krakow, Budapest, Vienna and Warsaw. Ostrava is a developing and vibrant city taking special care to cultivate public greenery. Its industrial heritage makes for a dramatic backdrop in which to study. It is an ideal destination for sightseeing. Nearby, there are two mountain ranges, Beskydy and Jeseníky mountains, which provide beautiful views of the landscapes and are perfect for hiking and skiing.
